HAM

This is the name given to white pork ham sold in Spain.

SERRANO HAM



EU ETG (Traditional Specialty Guaranteed) label to protect, classify and improve the image of traditional products produced in Community countries. It protects the traditional method of production and not the origin, as is the case with Protected Designations of Origin (PDO) or Protected Geographical Indications (PGI).

Protected Designations of Origin (DOP) are a certification system that guarantees the quality and origin of a product. Products that fall under an DOP are subject to strict quality control, ranging from production to processing and marketing.

IBERIAN PIG

Depending on their breed and their nutrition, they are differentiated into 4 types: cebo, cebo de campo, bellota, 100% bellota

The official guarantee seal is the seal that identifies the Iberian ham and all pieces (front and ham) MUST be marked with it.

50-75%-100% Iberian breed + feed + pastures



IBERICO BELLOTA HAM

50-75% Iberian breed + pastures + acorn



IBERICO 100% BELLOTA HAM

100% Iberian breed + pastures + acorn
